For he was one of the very best.

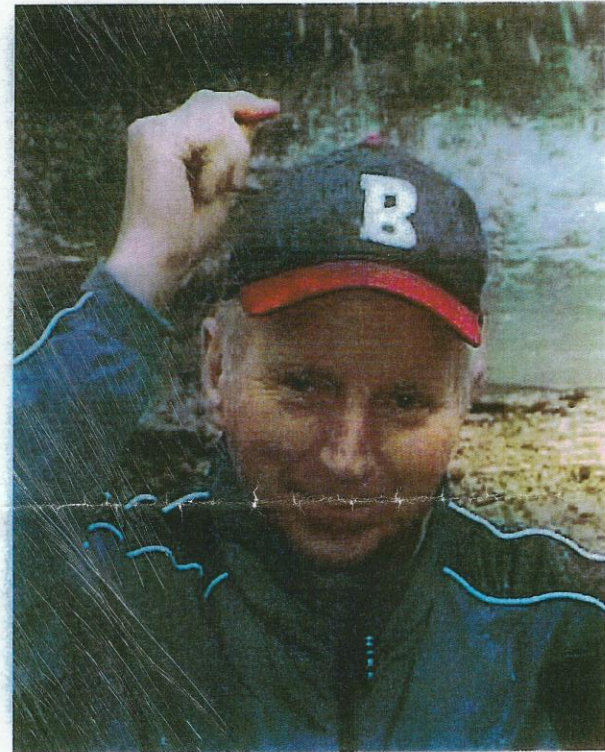
Now, let us learn to be like him
